This means that ACME site admins will lose their Confluence admin permissions, such as managing Confluence settings, space permissions, etc². QUESTION 2

Previously, your company had two Cloud organizations as shown.

Organization	Products
Original	Jira Software, Confluence
Destination	Jira Software

Just now, all products from Original were transferred to Destination. Afterward, Original was deleted. How does Jira Software appear on the Overview page of the Destination organization?

- A. as two products under the Destination URL only
- B. as a single product under the Original URL
- C. as a single product under the Destination URL
- D. as two products under the Original URL and Destination URL

Correct Answer: C

After the products from Original were transferred to Destination, Jira Software will appear as a single product under the Destination URL. This is because the Original organization was deleted, so there is no longer a separate URL for it.

- C. Any domain has been deleted.

- E. On the Edit domain page, Jira Software product role is set to None.

Correct Answer: E

When you add a domain to user access settings, you can specify the default product role for each product in your organization. This determines the level of access that users with verified email addresses from that domain will have when they join your site. If you set the product role to None, users will not have access to that product unless you manually grant them access later. References Specify how users get site access User access settings

QUESTION 5

Which statement is true about managed accounts in an organization?

- A. They come from verified domains.
- B. They must have product access.
- C. They come from approved domains.
- D. They have verified email addresses.
- E. They are all billable users.

Correct Answer: A

Managed accounts are accounts with an email address that you have claimed from your verified domain¹. Verifying a domain proves that you own it and allows you to manage the accounts associated with it². Managed accounts do not necessarily have product access, verified email addresses, or billable status.
