**QUESTION 1**

Correct Answer: A

Removing a user from an Atlassian Cloud Organization does not affect the subscription plan for the products. The subscription plan remains the same until you change it manually or it expires. The billing preview shows the estimated cost for the next billing cycle based on the current number of users and the subscription plan. If you remove a user, the billing preview will reflect the reduced cost, but the subscription plan will not change¹² References = Manage product access, Manage your bill for Standard and Premium plans

QUESTION 2

Laura went to Add People from within Jira.

She chose to invite Arjun to join Jira Software and Jira Service Management.

Arjun was able to join one of the products immediately but needed admin approval for the other.

What accounts for this difference?

- A. The "Invite anyone" setting is configured for one of the products but not the other.
- B. Laura is a Jira admin for one of the products but not the other.
- C. Laura's email address is unverified in one of the products but not the other.

Correct Answer: A



The "Invite anyone" setting allows users to invite anyone to join a product without admin approval. If this setting is enabled for one product but not the other, then Arjun can join the former product immediately but will need admin approval for the latter product. QUESTION 3

Holly just signed up for a new Confluence Cloud site.

What was definitely created along with the site?

Correct Answer: D

When Holly signed up for a new Confluence Cloud site, two groups were definitely created along with the site. These are the default groups for Confluence: confluence-users and site-admins. The confluence-users group grants access to Confluence and allows users to create and edit pages. The site-admins group grants administrative privileges for Confluence and allows users to manage global settings, templates, permissions, and more¹² References = Manage product access, Manage groups

QUESTION 4

You separated the group "engineers" into two new groups and then deleted the original group.

As a result, Joe and John had four problems in Jira.

Which problem did not occur?

- A. They could no longer select other users in dropdown fields.
- B. They could no longer view some dashboards.
- C. They could no longer edit their own comments.
- D. They could no longer transition issues.
- E. They could no longer view the billing history.

Correct Answer: E

The problem that did not occur for Joe and John is that they could no longer view the billing history. This is because the billing history is not related to the groups or permissions in Jira, but to the organization and site administration. Only the organization admin or the billing contact can view the billing history for the products and subscriptions¹² The other problems could have occurred for Joe and John if the group "engineers" had specific permissions or roles in Jira that were not granted to the new groups. For example, if the group "engineers" had the Browse Users global permission,



they could select other users in dropdown fields, such as assignee or reporter. If the group "engineers" had the View Dashboard project permission, they could view some dashboards that were shared with the project. If the group "engineers" had the Edit Own Comments issue permission, they could edit their own comments on issues. If the group "engineers" had the Transition Issues issue permission, they could transition issues from one status to another345
